1. Property Rights

Goal statement: All land use decisions made pursuant to this Comprehensive Plan shall protect the fundamental rights of all residents.

No adverse impact will result in the granting of the Special Use Permit. The modest proposed facility has a full-time staff of 2 that are housed within. The single access is to Moody Lane which minimizes traffic impact. The fundamental rights of all residents will be protected.

2. Population and Growth

Goal statement: The citizens of Ponderay desire to maintain the existing quality of life and plan for stable growth that is consistent with the City's character and within the fiscal capability of the community.

The proposed facility will provide an essential service to the citizens of Ponderay with shortened response times to medical emergencies. Future development outside of this project within the city limits of Ponderay will also be served.

4. Economic Development

Goal statements: To maintain and promote a healthy social and economic condition and development for City residents.

To promote the development and improvement of City infrastructure. Situating an EMS facility within the boundaries of the City of Ponderay is an addition to the City infrastructure as it will be provide essential services to the citizens.

As part of project scope, sidewalk will be added at the north property line, bordering on Kootenai Cutoff Road.

5. Land Use

Goal statements: Urban development should achieve wise use of Ponderay land resources.

Manage new growth and development to create a compact, distinct, and identifiable City.

Restrict development on and around sensitive lands and significant natural features, including wetlands and floodplains.

A centrally located EMS facility within the boundaries of Ponderay is needed and a wise use of existing property. The site is adjacent to existing commercial development and separated from existing multi-family development by horizontal distance and existing vegetation. The compact footprint of the proposed facility minimizes impact on the overall site and surrounding lands. No portion of the site has been designated wetlands and/or floodplains.

6. Natural Resources and Hazardous Areas

Goal statements: While conserving the environmental quality, the utilization of natural resources of Ponderay may be allowed.

To manage the area's natural resources through the development of policies that respect the area's important natural resources.

To protect the public safety, health and welfare from hazardous areas and conditions.

The proposed facility has a minimal impact on the site. No existing trees are to be removed. No hazardous areas would be developed as part of this project.

7. Public Services and Utilities

Goal statement: Plan for an orderly and efficient pattern of public facilities and services to serve as a framework for existing and future development. The central location of the proposed EMS facility allows quick and efficient access to all parts of

the City of Ponderay.

8. Transportation

Goal statement: To maintain the street system for current users, emergency response efforts, and future generation by providing for the safe and effective circulation of vehicular and pedestrian traffic.

The location of the proposed facility fronting Moody Lane will minimize traffic issues at Kootenai Cutoff Road, using an existing controlled intersection for ingress and egress.

A vehicular easement exists at the south edge of the property that ties to future road expansion in the City of Ponderay.
