# **Ponderay Community Ice Rink**

## **Frequently Asked Questions**

### **1. I have been hearing about an ice rink in Bonner County for years. Is this really going to happen?**

- Yes!!! The City of Ponderay and North Idaho Ice are so pleased to announce that a holiday ice rink **WILL** be open from Thanksgiving break through mid-January in Ponderay.
- The rink will be located on City property at the corner of Moonflower and Kootenai Cutoff Road near Highway 200

### **2. How is the Ponderay Community rink different from the proposed future rink at the Ponderay Field of Dreams?**

- The City of Ponderay and North Idaho Ice have always been of the opinion that we should start small with the ice facility, prove the interest and need and then grow it one step at a time. This rink is simply the first step in this progression.

#### **Ponderay Community Rink**

- The Ponderay Community Ice Rink will open in November 2024 is not being funded by the local option sales tax. However, it will likely end up at the Field of Dreams in the future and **will continue to operate as an ancillary rink for outdoor community and holiday skating even once the indoor ice facility is constructed.**
- This very affordable rink is a +/- 138'x80' uncovered outdoor rink and comes with a Zamboni, chiller, mats, boards and 300 pair of rental skates. This rink will cost approximately \$200,000 to get it up and running for the 2024 season.
- The Ponderay Community rink will operate during the holiday season for community skating and some organized events in the off hours.
- This low-cost option gets us operational now! Additionally, it lets us test the water, build interest and demonstrate community need before the Field of Dreams facility is constructed, which is substantially more expensive.

#### **Field of Dreams Ice Arena**

- The Ponderay Field of Dreams conceptual design includes an enclosed ice arena that will be constructed in phases.
- The proposed community rink does not replace this facility
- The City Council has indicated that the next Field of Dreams phase is slated to continue construction from the south end of the facility to the north. This would likely include phase one of the future ice arena.
- Future phases of the Field of Dreams development hinge on continued passage of the Ponderay Local Option sales tax for funding, which goes back to the voters in November of 2024.
- The City has purchased a full set of boards for a NHL sized ice arena which will be used in the future indoor rink at the Field of Dreams. They are being stored and still intend to be used for that purpose.

**3. If this rink is not being funded by the local option tax how is it being purchased and guaranteed to be operational in November of 2024?**

- The short answer is...**WE NEED YOUR HELP!**
- North Idaho Ice has negotiated the purchase of the Ponderay Community Ice Rink on a payment plan.
- The City of Ponderay has funded the first \$25,000 as a down payment which guarantee's deliver and ensures the rink will be set up and operational in November 2024.
- The remaining balance of the funds must be raised through a combination of Grants, Sponsorships, Donations and operational income by May of 2025 (via a series of scheduled payments)

**4. How can I help ensure that this rink will remain in the community for years to come?**

- The City of Ponderay and North Idaho Ice are organizing a series of fundraising events now through May of 2025. Watch the North Idaho Ice and City of Ponderay websites and follow us on Facebook and Instagram to stay up to date on fundraising events and to track our fundraising progress

**5. What happens if you raise more funds than are needed for the Ponderay Community Rink?**

- What a great problem to have!!!
- Not to worry! Any funds raised in excess of those needed to get the community rink up and going will be applied to improvements for the Outdoor Rink and/or the future indoor ice arena at the Ponderay Field of Dreams.

**6. How do I ensure my donations will be used for this purpose?**

- The City of Ponderay, North Idaho Ice and North Wilderness have entered into an ongoing memorandum of agreement which requires that all funds raised by the non-profits go to the City of Ponderay for the purpose of bringing ice to the Ponderay Community. In turn the City guarantees that all funds contributed by the non-profits will be spent for the purpose of an ice facility in Ponderay. It's a WIN WIN!
